- To understand the difference between shadows, reflections and refractions.
- To explain how the direction of a light beam can be changed.

## GEOGRAPHY

### International Trade.

- To understand where our food comes from.
- To understand why we import food.
- To identify the countries we import from the most and why
- To understand the impact of the demand for certain products.
- To understand how food gets to the UK.
- To compare and contrast different food chains.
- To understand what fair trade is and why we should support it.

## RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

### What can we learn from religions about deciding what is right and wrong?

- Explore religious teachings which are a guide for living.
- Explore the idea of temptation through religious stories.
- Share stories on how to live a 'good life'.
- Explore how we learn about wrong or right.
- Explore situations which are wrong or right.
- Explore the lives of inspirational religious figures.

### Relationships - Family Roles and Responsibilities

- To understand that changes happen in human bodies from birth to fully grown.
- To understand how babies grow and what is needed for them to develop.
- To identify that boy's and girl's bodies change on the outside and on the inside.
- Know the male and female parts of the body that are necessary to make babies.
- Know how a girl's body changes for her to have a baby (periods).
- Understand different types of families.
- Identify change and what I'm looking forward to in the next year.
